Old Cellphones Aren't Toys

When you get a new cellphone it may be tempting to use your old one as a backup phone or toy for the kids. While it may be a viable option, there are some pitfalls, particularly with 911 service.

When a normal cell phone calls 911, that phone's number and, in many cases, its actual location (provided by GPS) are sent along to the 911 center. That gives the dispatcher important information about who is calling and where they are calling from. (797-2704)

What many people don't realize, though, is that an old, inactive cellphone can still dial 911 (even if its SIM card is removed). And while that could be considered a benefit, it can also be a very big problem when left in the hands of children.

When an inactive cellphone calls 911, no number is passed through and the GPS data may not be available. The dispatcher answering the call may not be able to determine the actual location of the problem. And because the phone is inactive and cannot receive calls, the dispatcher or emergency crews cannot call you back if needed. (565-3102)

If the phone happens to be in the hands of a child who manages to call 911, the problems can get even worse. If the dispatcher is unable to verify whether or not there was a problem, they often times must send law enforcement to investigate, which can interfere with other emergencies.

So what's the bottom line? If you are going to get a new cellphone, the best option is to recycle the old phone. Not only does this help the environment, it can prevent possible problems later on. If you do decide to keep an old cellphone please be aware of the potential problems it can cause if misused.


